




Changes in Operating Revenues by Segment Q3 2015 Compared to Q3 2014






Changes in Segment Income by Segment Q3 2015 Compared to Q3 2014






Changes in Operating Revenues by Segment YTD 2015 Compared to YTD 2014





Changes in Segment Income by Segment YTD 2015 Compared to YTD 2014










Quarterly Performance Trend
